



B-21 Raider

- Conventional & Nuclear Capable
- Replaces the B-1 & B-2
- Built by Northrop Grumman in Palmdale, CA
- Aircraft Contract Award 27 Oct 15
- EAFB Officially Designated MOB 1 Jun 2021
- First Aircraft Arrival Mid-2020s
